Declared Pest Rate

Each year the DPR is reviewed by the Minister for Agriculture and Food upon recommendation from the EWBG, this DPR is then matched dollar for dollar by the State Government. Payment of the DPR by landholders in the EWBG prescribed area has been very high. This is much appreciated and under the BAM Act allows the EWBG to support landholders to meet their obligation to control declared pest on their property.

State Barrier Fence (SBF) Update

To date 300km SBF replaced, with a further 54km contracted for replacement by 2021. This equates to over one quarter of the entire length of the SBF. There has been 250km of grading and heavy earthworks completed to combat erosion issues along the fence, 65km of lapwire replaced, 55km of reposting completed and 400km of herbicide treatment completed.

R4Rs

On 14 December 2020, State Government announced \$13.4 million in continued funding to support the WA Wild Dog Action Plan for four years from 1 July 2021-30 June 2025. This includes \$800,000 per annum to support the employment of eight doggers who target control of wild dogs on government managed lands (refer to media release at bottom of email). The EWBG will continue to receive \$93,750 towards their LPMT.

Grants

EWBG were successful in two Industry Funding Scheme Grant. This will be the second year (in collaboration with the Central Wheatbelt Biosecurity Association) that the EWBG undertake an aerial baiting program targeting areas that are difficult to access by ground. The second grant will allow the EWBG to increase our existing part-time Junior Licensed Pest Management Technician (LPMT) position for 2020-21 and then have the ability to continue this position in 21/22 and 22/23.
